

PAPILLION PUBLIC ART

Cities gain value through public art – cultural, social, and economic value. Public art is a distinguishing part of our public history and our evolving culture. It provides an intersection between past, present and future, between disciplines, and between ideas. Public art is freely accessible. There is much to be gained and sustained from public art, and there is plenty of it in the works, thanks in part to one of PAF's component organizations.

The Papillion Area Council of Artists (formerly the Papillion Arts Council) is a non-profit organization established to promote, sustain and cultivate the visual arts in the Papillion area. As part of this mission, the group has taken on multiple projects that range from creating new public art to maintaining existing installations.

The Papio Trail Mural Project will enhance several points along the West Papio Trail with large-scale visual art. The first mural will be under the bridge on Washington Street with a targeted completion date before the 2025 Papillion Days celebration. Future murals along the trail include 96th, 72nd, and 66th streets. The PAC Artists have worked with the city as well as participants from the Sarpy Chamber's Leadership Sarpy program to complete this initial work. The PAC Artists have also developed and initiated a plan to make repairs on 19 of the 33 Butterfly Benches that were installed as part of the Papillion 150 celebrations in 2020. The remediation of outdoor wear on this public art project will ensure these benches are able to be enjoyed for many years to come.

THE STORY OF SUMTUR

The dream of Ken Molzer, retired Papillion Junior High Band Director and Director of the Papillion Area Concert Band, came true when the SumTur Amphitheater became a reality with the grand opening in June 2007. After 17 years of planning and fundraising, the first outdoor performing arts center in the metropolitan area was built thanks to the first two generous donors-- Wally & Elaine Sump and Wes & Ruby Turtscher, for which the SumTur Amphitheater is named.

Owned and operated by the City of Papillion, SumTur Amphitheater is a premier outdoor performance venue in the Omaha metropolitan area. Hosting over 100 events during its May through October season, this 1500-person capacity outdoor amphitheater provides endless opportunities for live family entertainment, private, nonprofit, and corporate rentals well as being a popular space for concerts, weddings, church services, and business events.

WHAT'S A CREATIVE DISTRICT?

The Papillion Arts Foundation, in collaboration with the City of Papillion, has been at work to obtain a Creative District certification within the city. We're excited to share more about what that designation means and invite you to get involved!

The Nebraska Creative District Program utilizes the arts as an economic driver to support communities in Nebraska by telling their stories and elevating the value of the arts.

Creative Districts are designated cultural and economic areas where innovation flourishes and neighborhoods come together in the name of art. They provide significant economic impact by creating purposeful spaces like art galleries, theatres, and music venues, attracting employees and businesses.

Having a certified Creative District in the city opens up a variety of opportunities for grants and resources to support the arts. Public input and feedback is vital to our work in applying for this designation and we hope you'll learn more about PAF and getting involved at www.papillionarts.org.



The Papillion Arts Foundation launched in 2023 with a mission to support, promote, and celebrate the arts in order to sustain a vibrant arts community and strengthen the cultural fabric of Papillion and the surrounding area. The organization acts as a hub where local arts nonprofits can build relationships with each other and partner with the city for unique arts experiences and opportunities.

PAF was created through the collaboration of existing arts nonprofits from a range of artistic disciplines. Representatives from the Papillion Area Community Singers, Papillion Area Concert Band, Papillion Area Council of Artists, and the Papillion Area Community Theatre met with officials from the City of Papillion and other area thought leaders in the nonprofit world to lay the groundwork for an organization with the power to uplift the entire arts community. These arts organizations each have a long history of working with the City of Papillion, and their experience was originally tapped to create a path for other arts organizations who may also be interested in partnering with the city.

The group's work resulted in the Papillion Arts Foundation, a partnership of local nonprofit arts organizations who have joined together for the purpose of growing opportunities for artistic and cultural enrichment in the Papillion area. The four arts nonprofits involved in the creation of PAF are now the founding members.

Member organizations pledge a percentage of their annual funds to the PAF and commit to attending regular meetings. These investments will help consolidate these organizations' strengths in the promotion of community arts and culture while maintaining their autonomy to focus on their individual arts programming. PAF membership is open to any local arts nonprofit interested in promoting creative collaboration and growing a vibrant arts community through their commitment to the foundation.
